Exam preparation

As you are aware the exam season is fast approaching and staff and students are working incredibly hard to ensure all students reach their potential. From Monday 14th May exam preparation sessions will commence. The full timetable for this is on the school website, and has been shared with students. Furthermore, as part of ongoing commitment to support our students, some students will have been invited into bespoke revision sessions during the May Half Term.

From **Monday 11th June** Year 13 Sports Academy students will be permitted to start their independent home study, unless I have communicated separately with you. Should students wish to come on site to study, outside of examination times, they will be required to sign in and out at reception.

If your child is unable to collect his/her results in person they must provide Mrs Natalie Dance, our Exams Officer, with a stamped addressed envelope or a letter stating that permission has been given to X (please state name of person) to collect the results on his/her behalf. This person must bring relevant identification on the day.
