RE: Year 11- Speaking Booklet and Exam

I am writing to inform you about a speaking booklet that your son/daughter has been preparing over the last few weeks in class in preparation for their speaking exam. The booklet has been filled in with example answers to questions they will be asked in their final exam. Over the Easter holidays your son/daughter should put time aside on a daily basis to practise their responses. This can be done with anyone, even if they don't have any understanding of the language being studied. It is vitally important that they practise regularly in order to be fully prepared for their exam.

Their final speaking exam, worth 25% of their overall grade, will take place on:

Either **Friday 27th April** or **Friday 4th May** for **Spanish**
Monday 30th April for **French**

I would like to also reiterate that the expectation is that your son/daughter is spending at least 10 minutes per day, 5 days per week on memorise in order to develop their vocabulary. This is vital in order to prepare them as best as possible for all aspects of their exams and has had a positive impact on their results in their mock exams.

I would also like to thank you for your continuous support throughout the GCSE course and for all of the hard work that your son/daughter is putting in to their language GCSE.
