The report contains two sets of information : **current** assessment and **previous** assessment. This allows you to see if progress is being made.

### Student target grade.

- This is the minimum grade your child should be hoping to achieve.
- Comparison with Predicted grade lets you know if your child is on track to meet targets by end of year 11.
- Comparison with Current grade lets you know if the target has been met in the work covered during this term.

### Student current grade.

- The current grade is the grade achieved in the work covered this term.
- This is not the grade he/she would achieve if he/she sat the GCSE at this point.
- It is an indicator of potential.

### Student predicted grade

- The predicted grade is the expected grade that your child would achieve in the GCSE exam based on all work covered to date.
