Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the English Literature GCSE course, students will be required to study three key texts:

- Modern Drama – “DNA” by Dennis Kelly,
- Nineteenth Century Literature – “Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde” by Robert Louis Stevenson, and
- Shakespeare – “Macbeth”

In this new era of closed book exams, which means copies of the texts will not be available in the final exam, it has become increasingly important that students are able to annotate their own copies which will ultimately be used for revision in Year 11. It is also preferable that all students are studying from the same editions of the texts for ease of page references.

With this in mind, we have secured a discounted deal to enable students to purchase all copies of the set texts directly from the English Department.

The cost for all three texts is £10.00 and we would ask that payment be made via your child’s existing sQuid account which will be available immediately.
