**Year 10 Geography Field Trip (GCSE compulsory component) to Bournemouth – Wednesday 19 June 2019**

As part of the GCSE Geography syllabus all students must participate in a compulsory field trip. In order to ensure that all Year 10 Geography students can achieve the highest possible grade in their GCSE examination, we have organised a **compulsory Geography field trip to Bournemouth on Wednesday 19 June 2019.**

The purpose of this trip is to complete the fieldwork section of the Unit 3 exam paper, 50% of which requires students to have completed two separate field studies. Visiting Bournemouth allows us to complete both studies in one day:

- Human Geography: A comparison of three tourist sites within Bournemouth
- Physical and human interaction: A study of the groynes on Bournemouth beach

Once in Bournemouth, we will focus our time around the pier, the Lower Gardens and in the town centre, where students will conduct bipolar surveys, and sand depth measurements along the groynes. Students will be completing a report with the data they have collected, part of which will be done before we go, and the remainder after we return to school. This report will then be revised and memorised to support the students in their fieldwork questions in the Unit 3 GCSE exam paper next year.

The total cost of this trip is £12 per student, and we request that you please make payment using our on-line e-payment system, with your child's sQuid account through the sQuid portal (<https://portal.squidcard.com/>), and you will be able to do this from today (closing date 15 May 2019). **Please return the attached permission slip directly to the Finance Office by 16 May once payment has been made.** Please note that due to the nature of this trip we are unable to refund the cost if your child is unable to go.

We will be using emergency contact details supplied on your child's 2018/19 OA4 Form (Off-Site Activities Form). Please ensure this has been completed and returned to school otherwise your child will not be allowed on this trip.

We will be departing Cox Green School at 8.45am, and shall return at approximately 5.00pm. Please arrange collection of your child accordingly. School uniform is not required to be worn on this trip, but students should wear comfortable appropriate clothing and footwear, bearing in mind they will be on their feet and outdoors throughout the day. Please provide a packed lunch/snacks and drinks for your student to last throughout the day. A reminder that chocolate, nuts and chewing gum are not permitted on the coach. In line with school policy, mobile phones are NOT permitted on this trip.

- Places on all trips are subject to the school Behaviour Policy.
