RE: GCSE PE – Practical Moderation Day

On **Tuesday 23rd April 2019**, the GCSE Physical Education Practical Moderation Day will be taking place.

An Edexcel moderator will be coming in to school to observe students participate in practical sessions where they will be graded as part of the practical element of the course. The practical element makes up 30% of the final grade and it is essential that everyone does their very best on the day.

For this day, students are to meet in the old gym at **8:30am** for registration and final preparations. The timetable is then as follows:

Students will need to bring their **full GCSE PE kit** which consists of plain black shorts/skort, plain black polo t-shirt (purple GCSE polo is acceptable), plain black tracksuit bottoms and a plain black jumper, all with or without the school logo. Students are asked to bring a rain jacket in the case of bad weather. Under **no circumstance** should students turn up in hoodies, sliders or any other items which are not uniform. If this is the case, students will be sent home immediately to change. Students will need to bring plenty of water and food to keep them going throughout the day. Students will return to lessons when they have completed their activities, so they also need to bring their exercise books and equipment for the lessons they have on this day. They will not be expected to bring their normal school uniform to school. Please ensure that your child brings no valuables to school on this day, and that all jewellery is removed prior to the 8.30am start, as health and safety forms part of the assessment process.
