Year 10 Voluntary Contributions – Hospitality and Catering

Your child is half way through their second year of his/her Key Stage 4 Hospitality and Catering Course. I am writing to request a voluntary contribution of £20.00 towards the cost of the basic materials. This will cover the remainder of the course through to the end of year 11.

In addition to homework, students are advised to watch TV programmes such as 'The Great British Bake Off', 'MasterChef' and 'Food Unwrapped.' These shows offer valuable learning opportunities on recipe ideas, cooking and presentation skills.
