### Home Study for Positive Behaviour

From January 2020, we will be introducing a new system for all Sixth Form students where positive behaviour is actively rewarded on a weekly basis.

Students who demonstrate each week that they have 100% attendance (unless absent for a pre-arranged appointment), are not late to school, wear the correct uniform and lanyard and demonstrate appropriate behaviour and learning expectations around school, will be rewarded with one weekly allocated home study lesson. **Our expectation and default position is that every student has one home study session per week, unless the behaviour expectations are not met.**

Home study sessions will be granted a week in arrears, so if permission for home study sessions is revoked, the student will be notified on the Friday preceding the revoked session.

Students have been allocated a fixed and non-negotiable lesson as home study for positive behaviour. If this is a period 5 lesson, then students will have permission to leave the school site after period 4. If this is a period 1 lesson, students have permission to arrive in school no less than 10 minutes prior to the start of period 2. **As part of this permission, students must sign in or out of school via reception in an orderly and quiet manner, otherwise future home study permissions may be at risk.**

During the duration of the home study, students only have permission to study at home and must not use this time to undertake paid work, socialise out of the house or to undertake driving lessons.

In order for students to take their allocated home study lesson, we will need parents to sign the attached form and return to school at your earliest convenience. Those students with parental permission and positive behaviour from the first week of term, will be allowed to utilise their allocated home study lessons during the week beginning 13 January, 2020.
