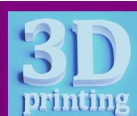

How to use the Library Computers for Homework and Research

Free 'preloaded' websites are available:

- Click on 'Internet Explorer'
- Go to the green 'e-Library : Learning Resources' box
- Select 'Homework/Research Help'
- Select 'Britannica Student Edition'
- Enter your keywords into the Search box

Left click on the title of the item you want to look at in the results list.

When you find the information you want:

- **Always** copy-and-paste from the website to Word, before printing off what you have found.

The printer is black and white, and printing is free.

You can also access all the free library websites on your laptop or from home at http://www3.rbwm.gov.uk/info/200341/online_library_resources/400/online_resources. You just need a library card barcode, no PIN required.
